

Copyright Transfer Agreement

Names of all authors:

- 1 This agreement complies with the provision of the *Copyright Law of the People's Republic of China*. Upon the signing of this agreement, the copyright of the above-mentioned article (including the copyright of any media), which should be an original work and not published at home and abroad, will be transferred to the editorial office of *Journal of Fisheries of China* worldwide. The editorial office, who owns the copyright of the article, will accept the article and publish it in the journal, and will pay a one-off remuneration (including transfer fee) to authors after publication. The editorial office has right to apply for copyright of any media for the article.
- 2 *Journal of Fisheries of China* is an open access journal. Once published, all articles will be immediately and permanently available for readers to read and download free of charge. Permitted third party reuse of the articles published by the journal is defined by the following user license: Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 (CC BY-NC-ND 4.0). This license allows reusers to copy and redistribute the material in any medium or format. The licensor cannot revoke these freedoms as long as the license terms below are followed: reusers must give appropriate credit, provide a link to the license, and indicate if changes were made. Reusers may do so in any reasonable manner, but not in any way that suggests the licensor endorses the use. Reusers may not use the material for commercial purposes. If reusers remix, transform, or build upon the material, they may not distribute the modified material.

3 The authors of the article mentioned above may have right to use the article in following ways whereas they should always state that the copyright of all copies of the article belong to the editorial office of *Journal of Fisheries of China*, and that the article is open access under CC BY-NC-ND 4.0 license. The authors have the right to use the article under CC BY-NC-ND 4.0 license. In addition:

- (1) Though the copyright financial right is transferred, authors keep the copyright personal right.
- (2) A third-party can republish the article or its translation or extract without using the layout of *Journal of Fisheries of China*. Permission from the editorial office of *Journal of Fisheries of China* is not necessary in this case.
- (3) After the article is published in the *Journal of Fisheries of China*, authors have right to use the published version of the article in whole or in part without revision for compiling personal anthologies or other personal works (including uploading the article to author's personal webpage).
- (4) Authors have right to reproduce the article in whole or in part during his study, research, lectures and classes.
- (5) Authors have right to post or update the article on an e-print (publication) server whereas the authorship and citation should be clearly marked.
- (6) If the article is a working task of a legal person or organization, the legal person or organization has right to copy the article for internal use within its business scope.

4 By signing this agreement, authors promise:

- (1) The article is a research achievement independently obtained by authors and has not been published elsewhere.
- (2) The article involves no multiple submission, nor has been published in other journals in any form.
- (3) The article is not a salami-slicing (multiple papers produced using variables from the same dataset).
- (4) There is no plagiarism or improper citation in the article.
- (5) There is no dispute about the order of authors and institutes.

- 5 Authors shall ensure that confidentiality and patent content are not involved. Infringement of copyright or other rights of third-parties shall be averted.
- 6 This agreement is binding upon all authors. The signed authors must strictly observe the provision of this agreement and academic guidelines. If authors submit a photocopy of the agreement, it shall be deemed as having the same legal effect as the original copy.
